Research the product. In order to demonstrate to your readers that your review is reliable, make sure to conduct as much research as possible before you begin writing. A thorough knowledge of the product, its evolution and its competition will allow you to write something approaching an expert review. An ideal summary should at least have the following six elements: A short sentence identifying the product and its intended use. Product ratings under different headers. "Value for Money", "Support", "Effectiveness", etc. are some common. Make these visual by using icons. A summary of the product's pros and cons. Karol – I agree with you that some people write reviews without actually using or buying the product or service. It of course is very clearly visible from the content of their review. Listing out the Pros and Cons in a simple bullet formatted content will provide an immediate snapshot to the reader. Ideally, a product review should come from an independent author. Such a reviewer would presumably shed light on various products, and represent a neutral, unbiased perspective. Otherwise, when reviews are crafted by in-house content creators with skin in the game, they lack credibility and are rather one-sided.
