RSS (Rich Site Summary; originally RDF Site Summary; often called Really Simple Syndication) is a type of web feed which allows users to access updates to online content in a standardized, computer-readable format. These feeds can, for example, allow a user to keep track of many different websites in a single news aggregator. If you're looking for a job, you can craft your own RSS feeds at [Monster.com](http://Monster.com), or use one of their own pre-programmed RSS feeds instead. To craft your own, simply do a search for your specific needs, and then subscribe to the search results via your feed reader of choice. RSS Feed Readers and News Aggregators

Feed Reader or News Aggregator software allow you to grab the RSS feeds from various sites and display them for you to read and use. A variety of RSS Readers are available for different platforms. RSS (really simple syndication) service is a means by which [CNN.com](http://CNN.com) offers feeds of story headlines in XML format ("RSS Content") to visitors to [CNN.com](http://CNN.com) (the "CNN Site") who use RSS aggregators.
